INFORMATION SHEET - Home Economics/Hospitality teachers,

Further to discussions with a group of the district's Home Economics/Hospitality teachers at Harrup Park on 21st November 2002, the Rotary Club of Port of Mackay will be organising a Young Chefs Competition this year in co-operation with local schools.

It is planned to take place in two stages:

- The **preliminary heats** will be held within each school during the **first term** at the discretion of the Home Economics/Catering Teacher. The heats will be judged by members of Rotary in conjunction with teachers from the school.
- The winners will go on to the **finals** to compete for the **Sponsor's Shield** planned for **sometime between mid-May and the first week of June**. These finals, involving winners from other local schools will be conducted at the Mackay TAFE College. The final date will be organized by Rotary who will liaise carefully with schools to avoid clashing with any examinations. The finals, hopefully, will be judged by a well known professional chef.

The competition is open to all students and will have two divisions:

- Junior division - Years 8, 9 and 10
- Senior division - Years 11 and 12

Both divisions will involve the students working in pairs not individually.
